Who Should Attend

Experienced managers employed in the public sector for five or more years who have had substantial supervisory experience. Individuals passing from a technical or professional specialty into a broader general management position.

Program Highlights

- Develop an understanding of the political, economic and social context of public administration;
- Achieve substantial competency in organization analysis and in management techniques;
- Gain experience in applying qualitative and quantitative methods to public policy issues;
- Provide participants with study options that focus on substantive coursework in advanced and specialized areas; and
- Participants are required to take selected graduate level courses and one three credit executive seminar in public administration. Other seminars are added based on student need and faculty availability.
